St Day AFC are linking up with St Day & Carharrack Community Primary School, to offer young people, Boys & Girls, of all abilities the chance to play football for not just a football club but their own local village football club.

The club were approached by teacher Mr. Ben Bowden on behalf of Headteacher Mrs. Jenny Green, both expressing help to deliver coaching within school, after hearing the ever growing success of our youth section.

For 5 weeks, starting March, we will be coaching students from the school, aged 4-11, from 3:30-4:30, with the chance at the end to join the club's 6 week block training session on Saturday mornings, where we currently have on average 30 youngsters every Saturday morning, from 10:30am—12pm.

## Youth Update..

The progression towards entering teams into the Kernow league next season 2012/2013 is really taking shape. Age group teams have to be finalised with myself, the coaches and the CCFA all in agreement, but as always as soon as we know we will inform you. We will in the very near future be holding a meeting with all parents and interested people to hopefully help you understand what St Day AFC is trying to achieve with youth and bring you up to speed with developments on next season. We have applied for a grant which will enable us to take the youth onwards. Should we succeed with this grant, the money will help us and the youth in many ways. We will be able to affiliate teams, train more coaches, pay referees, hire venues to train if too wet and also keep the children looking smart along with plenty of equipment to use which will progress their development skills.

Whilst talking about training coaches, if there is anyone interested in becoming a qualified Level 1 coach, please approach myself. With this grant money we would be able put you through the course at no cost to yourself. This would mean you could get involved with youth football anywhere you wish, but hopefully here at St Day. Future dates are being released shortly, so please do not hesitate. The club coaches, Roxanne, Nathan, Joe, Aaron and Tom are all here to support you and would answer any questions that you may have.

I am also pleased to announce that a new kit has arrived for the youth team, (Pictured Left), which has been kindly sponsored by John Orchard Scrap Yard and I'm working to get this sorted for the next match at the end of March. The youngsters will own their shorts and socks and the shirts will be produced on match days. They can then arrive to a match in them and along with their replica club polo top, which will really make them look smart.



Some other things to up date you on, we will be entering a team into the well know Sharon Wood Tournament at Wendron FC, which is taking place at the end of July. We have recently been contacted by Redruth Charity Trust, expressing their delight at being able to offer us equipment, clothing or even Trophies at there presentation evening in May. We are now putting together a wish list of items for the youth section, which will include the possibility of being funded Tracksuits for the youngsters as well as some new goals and size 3 & 4 balls.
