CHILDREN'S UNIVERSITY IS COMING TO ST DAY YOUTH AFC

The Children's UniversityTM is a national project which recognises the achievements of young people who take part in high quality out of hours learning activities.

These activities can be run at a school as an after school club or may be offered by other 'Learning Destinations', such as a museum, library or community club. The aim of the Children's University is to raise the aspirations of our young people by introducing them to a wide range of quality learning opportunities and a love of lifelong learning.

The students' achievements are celebrated and rewarded through certificates which they receive for completing 30, 65 and 100 hours of participation in validated activities. Bronze certificates are awarded in school assemblies but Silver and Gold certificates will be presented at local 'graduation' ceremonies. In Cornwall, the age range for Children's University is 5-14 but we plan to develop a similar programme for older students, linked in with external accreditation bodies. Full list of awards are as follows......

100 hrs (Gold Award)

130 hrs (Bronze Certificate)

165 hrs (Silver Certificate)
