OUALIFIED & SAFE....

St Day can now boost even more qualified people involved within the club.

During October & November volunteers went through a lot of individual courses so that they become qualified for the youth section.

7 people now boost being level 1 coaches, which takes the total to 12 now involved in the youth section. This involved attending a safeguarding children workshop, first aid, LTPD workshop & 2 Sunday practical sessions. This took approx 21 hours over 4 weeks.

2 people became qualified as Welfare Officers, again this included attending safeguarding & first aid workshops as well as a welfare officers workshop. This took approx 10 hours.
