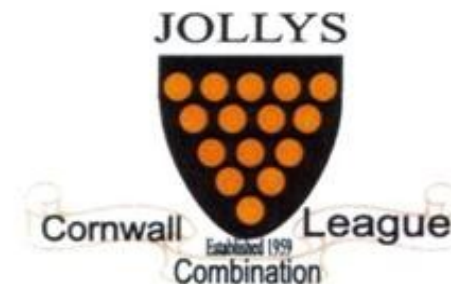

Good afternoon and may we welcome you to Vougue Park, St Day, for the second of this year's League Cup semi-finals.

First can we thank St Day, their officials and ground-staff for allowing their facilities to be used today. There will be a tea-hut and bar open upstairs in their clubhouse for your comfort.

Illogan RBL and Perranwell are playing to meet St Day, who defeated Mullion 2-1 in last Sunday's other semi-final, played at a cold and windy Ludgvan. The winners of both matches will go on to play in the traditional Easter Sunday Final on 31st March which this year is being held at Porthleven.

Should today's match finish as a draw after ninety minutes, extra-time will be played and if needed, penalties will decide the outcome.

Many thanks to today's referee, Adam Price and his assistants, Ben Lugg and Ciaran Barlow for officiating today's match.

From the League's inception, 1959-60, until the start of the 1981-82 season the League Cup was competed for by dividing the clubs into divisional geographical mini-leagues with the sides within those mini-leagues playing each other on a home and away basis. At the start of competition there were only two divisions so the winners of each mini-league went strait onto the final. As the number of clubs in the League increased a third, then a fourth mini-league were formed. For several seasons one of the mini-leagues only consisted of the two "Services" sides, RNAS Culdrose and RAF St Mawgan. One reason why in the late 70's Culdrose

With the number of league sides increasing it was decided that the clubs couldn't play the mini-league system, their league and Senior Cup games so the League Cup was altered to a knock-out format as it is today. Replays took place until the start of last season when it was decided that all games had to finish on the day.

The Supplementary Cup was introduced for the start of the 1985-86 season and was played for by the clubs knocked out in the preliminary and first rounds of the League Cup.

Between them Illogan and Perranwell have won the League Cup six times and have appeared in another seven finals. In the Supplementary Cup Illogan have reached the final once, and won, whilst Perranwell have reached three finals but lost them all.

Being two of the most consistent sides in the league you would think that they would meet each other quite often in the Cup but their one and only previous meeting since the Cup became a knockout competition was in the 1993-94 when Perranwell defeated Illogan 2-1 in the first round. Perranwell went on to win the Cup that year defeating Porthleven 7-0 in the final.

Perhaps a better record of their meetings is in league matches. Up till the end of last season they have played 62 times with 19 wins for Illogan, 34 for Perranwell and only 6 draws. Illogan have scored 99 goals whilst conceding 151.

But do we go on that record as cup games are one-offs? Will history repeat itself and we get the same result as 1993-94?
